Shire of Waroona

Safer Crossings

PROJECT SUMMARY

To engage a traffic calming expert and facilitate a community engagement process to understand local attitudes and behaviours and use the insights to co-design street calming solutions with the community. The aim is to improve the pedestrian access from South Western Highway to Railside Park, and integrate the design with existing themes.

City of Mandurah

Miami Village Heart

PROJECT SUMMARY

The project plans to calm traffic in Miami Village by installing parklets with artificial lawn, seating, and planters, and to add vibrancy through temporary art installations created by local youth and community members. The initiative includes a trial closure of one Miami Village access points to improve pedestrian access.

Monger Street Safety Initiative

PROJECT SUMMARY

To enhance traffic safety and street vibrancy by improving the public space in the town centre, there will be an installation of street furniture and colourful planter boxes with community design and install. This pilot project will test and evaluate traffic behaviour to determine its effectiveness, with the goal of expanding to larger-scale safety measures based on observed outcomes and community feedback.

Brookton Streets Alive for Safer Roads

PROJECT SUMMARY

To engage the local community for research on road safety issues in Brookton (at Williams St. and Brookton Highway) to inform a Design Plan for future street calming installations.

White Street Mural

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install asphalt art on White Street, across from the local daycare and primary school to enhance road safety, calm traffic, and further promote the safety of child commuters.

Merredin Community Resource Centre Inc

VIBRANCY ON BARRACK

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install street furniture, plants, other greenery, and footpath art on Barrack St, Merredin WA, as a trial to increase road safety, calm traffic and inform an Action Plan to install a roundabout near the school to make it more visible & user friendly.

Northam Town Team

Northam Play Street Project

PROJECT SUMMARY

Research into the road safety experiences, attitudes, behaviours and concerns of citizens of Northam. Two workshops will be held, one for children aged 0–6 and one for children aged 7–15, to gather insights and co-design street calming solutions. The outcomes and recommendations will be summarised into a report and shared with the Local Government and community for further development.

Energising Our Rural Routes

PROJECT SUMMARY

To collaborate with the community to produce a street mural design and install other traffic calming features on Railway Ave., to address road safety concerns and make the town more welcoming.

Shire of Bruce Rock

Rooftop Bus Stop Mural Installation for Road Safety Enhancement

PROJECT SUMMARY

The project plans to create and install a mural on the roof of a bus stop in Bruce Rock's main business precinct. The mural will promote safe, people-friendly roads and align with a broader main street revitalization strategy, which includes traffic calming artwork, designated crossings, and supportive landscaping.

Shire of Cunderdin

ArtDrive: Igniting Road Safety through Community Creativity

PROJECT SUMMARY

Community events held in Cunderdin and Meckering to gather road safety insights and develop a street calming action plan for both towns. The events will actively engage local residents by inviting them to install and decorate seating and planter boxes that aim to create safer and more walkable streets. On its completion, the street calming action plans will be shared with the Local Government and community.

Shire of Dandaragan

Shingle Avenue Traffic Calming

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Shire plans to install traffic calming and road safety features of light-coloured pavers with stencilled line markings at each speed hump along Shingle Avenue.

Moora Street Arts Project Stage 1

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install footpath art by a local indigenous artist, community design and install of signage and bollards at the intersection of Midlands Road and Dandaragan Streets as a traffic calming feature and increase road safety for pedestrians.
