### Trial semi-permanent alfresco furniture to activate street -Beechboro Road South

#### **PROJECT SUMMARY**

To trial semi-permanent alfresco street furniture at Beechboro Road South and the corner of Foyle Road/Beechboro Road South support a revitalization project to enhance the area and calm traffic. The project involves collaborating with multiple community stakeholders and the local government in a vision for a future permanent installation.

Engagement activities to increase road safety awareness.

The outcomes and recommendations will be summarised into a report and shared with the Local Government and community for further development.
