PROJECT SUMMARY

To engage a consultant to coordinate with community stakeholders, through multiple workshops, on the formation of an Action and Design Plan to increase road safety and promote active transport near Davidson Terrace. The project supports the Joondalup City Centre Place Activation Plan's goals, particularly enhancing pedestrian-friendly streets.

PROJECT SUMMARY

A community- led initiative to design a road mural, and engage a local artist to install a mural as a traffic calming feature to increase road safety in a high pedestrian usage area on Gritten Lane, adjacent to Hancock Street Park.

PROJECT SUMMARY

The project aims to improve safety and amenities in an area with many businesses, anticipating resistance due to potential impacts on access and parking. It involves engaging the community to co-create and test solutions, beginning with research on local attitudes and needs, and running workshops to develop and assess concept designs.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Installation of a road mural by professional artist, Olive Cheng on Northwood Street with community design to manage traffic flow, create safe crossings, and install with amenities like seating, bike racks, rubbish bins to increase road safety and calm traffic.

Girrawheen Neighbourhood Network

WA Spray Days - Girrawheen

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install a wall mural on the in Girrawheen to boost local morale and promote active transport and road safety around a high pedestrian traffic area at Templeton Crescent and Hudson Avenue as a traffic calming feature.

Glendale Primary School P&C Association

Glendale Avenue road safety mascot

PROJECT SUMMARY

Develop a design for, in collaboration with students at Glendale Primary school, a Western-Australian animal 'road safety mascot' and install the mascot on the footpaths along key points on Glendale Avenue to address community concerns around pedestrian, student, and community safety along Glendale Avenue.

Mount Hawthorn Hub

Walk, Skip, Hop Jump in the Park

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install footpath art, by artist Olive Cheng, designed by the local community, around Braithwaite Park on Beach Road to enhance community connections and promote pedestrian and child safety through traffic calming.

North Perth Cricket Club

Street Cricket for Safer Streets

PROJECT SUMMARY

Community events to inform an Action Plan for making streets safe for children and other pedestrians. Qualitative surveys based on the Healthy Streets approach will be used to gauge community perceptions of safety. Further research into traffic calming solutions, using the MRWA Low Cost Urban Road Safety treatments to inform design options, will be used to form an Design Plan.

West Perth Local Inc

West Perth Native BeeScene Pedestrian Safety

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install graphic art signage along Outram Street and cross streets between West Perth Village and Kings Park to enhance pedestrian safety and calm traffic. These complement existing elements of the West Perth Native BeeScene Project, including murals and native plant installations.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Community education and research into the local road safety attitudes and behaviours relating to the Victoria Street and Gibbon Street intersection in Mosman Park. Community insights will be used to co-design a street calming intervention with a consultant and share the concept with the Local Government.

PROJECT SUMMARY

To trial a street calming solution over four months at Railway St crossing and install traffic calming features to increase pedestrian usage of crossing and ensure safety of children commuting to school.

The installation of lighting treatments along Angove Street that aim to enhance visibility of pedestrians, reduce speed and increase feelings of safety.
