Mingenew Rejuvenation Project

PROJECT SUMMARY

To install a mural on the facade of Mingenev Supermarket, Midlands Rd as a traffic calming measure.

The mural, conceived through community feedback, will incorporate elements reflecting the indigenous culture and history of the area, linking traditional and modern concepts.

PROJECT SUMMARY

Engage in planning of a larger street art project by professional artists presenting artistic concepts that will be used in a subsequent, larger project aimed at creating and installing street art across key areas in the Shire of Chapman Valley to calm traffic and revitalise the region, showcasing the diverse and thriving community.

PROJECT SUMMARY

PROJECT SUMMARY

To complete Traffic Management Training for 5 people (community members and Shire staff) resulting in the participants of the training being available for nonprofit organisations free of charge, and being able to utilise the skill of members to charge a fee for service to commercial event organisation, benefiting the groups in Nannup in ensuring road safety for events and gatherings.
